

**The Department of Public Works will collect holiday trees and greenery by appointment or at drop-off locations
December 27 – January 31.**

**Residents in DPW-serviced households should call 311 between
December 27 & January 10 to make their appointment.**

**Residents may also take their trees and greenery to a drop-off
location December 27 – January 31.**

- DPW crews will collect holiday trees and greenery from the front of residents' houses.
- Trees and greenery collected between December 27 and January 31 (and those brought to the drop off locations) will be composted.
- When residents set their trees and greenery out for collection, we ask that they please remove all ornaments and lights and do not put trees and greenery in a bag.
- After January 31, residents should place holiday trees and greenery where their trash is collected. It will be picked up with your trash as space in our trucks permits. Unfortunately, trees and greenery collected after January 31 will not be composted.
- Free compost – up to five 32-gallon bags – is available for District residents year-round while supplies last at the Fort Totten Transfer Station. Bring your own bags.
